Application process

To Apply to the WELLER Accredited MBA Program, you must follow these steps :

1.Contact an Admissions Officer

Send a copy of your resume or curriculum vitae in English including your possible professional experience and educational information in order to find out if you are qualified to apply for the program. An official will review your qualifications and let you know immediately if you should submit a full application file. The basic qualifications are: a four-year university degree and proficiency in English.

2 Mail your application packet

Submit a letter of candidacy in English explaining why you wish to do an MBA program, a passport-style photograph, photocopies of your university diplomas and the application fee of 80 Euros, or the equivalent in any currency, in the forms of a check made out to WELLER. Mail these items directly to the main office at WELLER's address. The application fee is reimbursed if you are not accepted on the program. The admission officer will tell you by when you must submit the application packet.

3 Interview and Test

Once the complete application packet is received at the main office, an admission officer will contact you to fix the date for your interview and a one hour test. For students living far away, a telephone interview will be organized in place of a face to face interview.

4 Result and contract

You must call the main office seven days after your test and interview to find out the result. If accepted on the program, you will be asked to return to the main office seven days later to sign an enrolment contract and make a payment of 50% of your total tuition fees. The remaining 50 % will be asked for on the first day of the program at the latest.

5. Non European Union students

It is absolutely obligatory to have a visa. Once the candidate is admitted and the tuition fees paid, WELLER's administration will provide all the documents relevant to obtaining a visa. The student should then present those documents to the french embassy in the country of origin. If the visa application is rejected, despite our best effort, the tuition fees will be reimbursed in full.
